Teachers will work toward getting those students to a proficient level. Schools are only rated on the SBAC scores. Mrs. Adams is not worried, and is confident that we will be able to get our 5-start rating back. There is no tutoring this year. We have Nina Johnson as our Ready by Three strategist to help and work with small groups.
